

CAN I ATTEND SCHOOL TODAY?

In the **last 14 days**, have you had any direct contact (*within 6 feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes*) with anyone who has COVID-19 or traveled outside of San Juan County, New Mexico?

In the last 48 hours, have you experienced any of these daily screening symptoms?

- New/Unexplained cough (*for students with chronic allergic/asthmatic cough, a change in their cough from baseline*)
- Fever (>100.4° F)
- Sore Throat
- Nausea/Vomiting/Diarrhea
- New loss of taste/smell
- Shortness of breath
- Weakness
- Chills
- Unexplained muscle pain

YES

Do NOT attend school!

You must remain at home until you have been symptom and fever free for 48 hours without the use of symptom reducing medications such as Tylenol, Ibuprofen, or Imodium.

*It is recommended that you call your healthcare provider. If you believe you have been exposed to COVID-19, contact the San Juan County Public Health Office or your healthcare provider to arranging testing.

**Once you are symptom free for 48 hours, or receive a release from their healthcare provider they may return to school.

Please continue:

- Daily screening for symptoms
- Wearing a facial mask/covering
- Frequent hand washing
- Social distancing
