SEASONAL ALLERGIES

Allergies vary from person to person They tend to be seasonal, linked to specific pollens Allergies may be tied to many environmental factors While a person with allergies may sneeze and cough, they rarely have a fever. They often have red, watery eyes.

As a note, if a student or a staff member has a cold or flu-like symptoms, they must be fever-free without fever reducing medication for 24 hours and have improving symptoms before returning to school.
